## 2020 USAHA & AAVLD ANNUAL MEETING • VIRTUAL 2020 FAQ'S

## **Registration**

- 1) Where do I register?
  - https://www.usaha.org/meeting-registration
- 2) When do I have to register by?
  - We are asking all participants to register by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 to ensure that you can gain access to the virtual meeting platform on October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- 3) Can I register after October 1st, 2020?
  - Yes, however, please note that it can take 2-3 business days to gain access to the virtual platform. We are not able to grant instant access to the platform. If there is a meeting you wish to attend please register well in advance, and if possible, by October 1st, 2020.
- 4) Do I have to be registered for the virtual meeting to attend a specific symposium, special event, or committee meeting?
  - YES! Like the in-person meeting, you are not able to attend any meeting or sessions until you have registered and received your badge. This also applies to the AAVLD Foundation Auction and Joint Presidents' Reception and Awards Ceremony. We are offering a one-day pass option if you are not interested in attending the whole meeting.
- 5) Do I have to attend the whole meeting or is there a one-day pass?
  - We are offering a one-day pass. When you register you will indicate which day you would like to have access to in the virtual meeting platform.
- 6) Is there an additional fee for AAVLD symposiums?
  - Some symposiums will require an additional fee and some are free, but ALL symposiums require that you pre-register. If you do not pre-register for any symposiums you will not be able to access them in your schedule page.

## Virtual Meeting Access

- 1) How and when do I get my meeting access information?
  - We are urging all participants to register on or before October 1, 2020. For those who register by this deadline, you will receive an email containing your login information by 9:00 AM EDT on October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020. If you register after October 1<sup>st</sup>,

2020 we will work diligently to grant you access to the system as soon as possible. However, please note that this can take 2-3 business days.

- 2) What email address can I expect to receive my meeting access information from?
  - Your login credentials will come from <a href="mobilesolutions@psav.live">mobilesolutions@psav.live</a>
  - Please add this email address to your contacts so you don't miss the email. Be sure to also check your spam folders.
- 3) My meeting access information email contains a password. Can I change this once I log into the platform?
  - No. Once your password is assigned to you that will be your password for the duration of the meeting. You are not able to change this password so please keep this handy!
- 4) I have registered for the annual meeting, but I have not received my login credentials. Now what?

If you registered for the annual meeting after the October 1st deadline please note that it can take 2-3 business days to grant you access to the platform. - 5) What access do I get with registration?
  - All open meetings, committees, scientific sessions, trade show, and on-demand content. Only closed sessions or pre-paid symposiums will have limited access. Much like the normal meeting, any registrant can have access to both USAHA and AAVLD sessions.
